Class 1

12 years and under Team and Individual Jumping—fences approx 2ft (Rosettes for the Best 10 and under team—please give ages when entering)

Any pony/rider combination entering Class 1 cannot enter Classes 3, 4 or 5

Class 2

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age
Fences 2ft 3” - 2ft 6”

Class 3

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age
Fences 2ft 6” - 2ft 9”

Class 4

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age
Fences 3ft—3ft 3”

Class 5

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age
Fences 3ft 3” - 3ft - 6

(Classes 1—4 Single Phase) (Class 5—Table A)

Cost: £36 per team—£9 per individual

Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place for individual and teams.
Teams to consist of 3 or 4 riders with the best 3 scores of each team to count

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Ages as at 1st January 2010
- All classes as per Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2010
- Pony Club members must wear crash hats to BSEN 1384, PAS015 or ASTM F1163.
Any other competitor must wear hats to standard BS 4472 or BS 6473
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or amend the order of classes or cancel classes
- * Any objections to be notified to the Secretary within half an hour of the incident with a deposit of £10 - non-refundable if over-ruled by the Chief Steward
- The decision of the organisers is final
- Spectators and competitors attend entirely at their own risk and the Committee will not be held
- responsible for any loss/accident/injury or damage that may occur to them, their horse/pony or property
- The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
